Method of scoring. Each section is scored up to 10 points (10%). A total 'minimum' passable score would be an accumulated figure of 82%. An 'average' pass would be considered 85% (8.5 per section). However, if the applicant is a junior (or is categorised as 'special needs'), and his score is below that of 82%, he may pass as a Shodan-ho/Nidan-ho if he has achieved 72% or above in both written and practical aspects of the grading.
